Swinley Forest Golf Club invests in Baroness

The club dates back to 1909 when it was designed by the legendary Harry Colt. It is said to have been his favourite amongst all the celebrated courses for which he was responsible.

Golfing Monthly describes the heathland course as a 'jewel'. It goes on: 'There are few centurion courses so perfectly designed and in such a wonderful location that little has changed or ever needs to. Swinley Forest is one such shining diamond, and despite recent tweaks you genuinely feel as though you are stepping back in time from the moment you arrive.'

John's overall priority is clear. "Presentation of the course has to be to a very high standard and that's why I bought these new machines for the tees," he says. "The previous mowers that we were using simply didn't give me the quality of cut — we were using greens units on the tees so they had too many blades and didn't produce the quality of cut."

The tees are small and many have banks alongside them — they weren't designed for triples and need to be hand cut. "So far, the Baroness machines are doing a good job. The lads all like using them which is unusual given the fact that there are seven of them all agreeing on one machine – it doesn't happen very often!"

"They are particularly happy with the fact that the controls allow you to feather the speed. That gives them much closer control on small greens where you are turning constantly."

"The other very noticeable point is that they are staying on cut where our old machine needed to be re-adjusted every time it went out."

He adds: "Baroness is a new name for us but everyone I have spoken to who has used them for a while says they are still going strong and are reliable."

The LM56s are completely gear-driven which makes them easier to maintain and more durable than belt or chain-driven mowers. They also have the benefit of cylinder blades made from a unique combination of nickel, chrome and molybdenum and specially hardened tipped bedknives. It means that Baroness cylinders have earned a reputation for keeping their cutting edge for longer than any other mower.

The LM56 is also much more than just a mower in that it can be equipped with a bi-directional front grooming reel, de-thatching reel or brush, all of which are gear-driven and interchangeable within five minutes. The result is a complete turf management system in one mower.

It's a measure of Swinley Forest Golf Course that it is investing significant funds specifically in its tees with the arrival of not one but three Baroness LM56 pedestrian mowers to further boost its impressive standards of presentation.

As one of a golden group of prestigious courses within a mile or so of one another on the Berkshire/Surrey border, Swinley Forest doesn't take its status as arguably one of the world's best courses for granted. The trio of LM56s supplied by Lister Wilder therefore had to come through a rigorous selection process.

It's still early days for him to give a full verdict on their performance but Head Greenkeeper John Band, and his team of nine are impressed with what they are seeing to date.

John came to the club 27 years ago to do some construction work ... but never left as he had originally intended to return to

a farming life in Herefordshire. The course became not just his career but a family home given that he lives on site. He took on his present role three years ago and has led a programme which includes extensive refurbishment to greens and tees, so adding 400 yards to the course plus a new practice ground and short game area. The greenkeeping team is also intent on de-thatching and renewal of heather areas as well as upping the quality of the tees (of which there are at least four per hole).

The work on the course is part of a wider period of change for a traditional club that still operates very successfully without the need for a website or advertising. It does, however, now welcome golfing societies Monday to Friday through most of the year. And you can nowadays play there on a green fees basis.

Avington Park Golf Course invests in Baroness



There was particular reassurance for Avington Park in the reliability of a mechanical drive to the cutting units and the fact that the 11-blade floating-head cutting units are driven not by hydraulics or electric motors, but by a quick-attach cable drive system. Having previously suffered a green devastated by a hydraulic leak, they much preferred to rule it out for the future.

But the simplicity of the Baroness would, of course, mean little if the Avington Park crew couldn't also salute its performance. They go along with many others in praising the sheer quality of the cut, which is built on the brand's world-leading reel and specially hardened bed knife technology.

Says Kevin: "Everyone has commented on the quality of the greens. We get more cuts per square yard from the Baroness blades, and the bi-directional groomers are a lot more aggressive in getting the lateral growth out. They work exceptionally well."



He adds: "We liked the fact that Lister Wilder are a substantial dealership and the clincher was that the Baroness UK headquarters is just a few miles away in Basingstoke. Lister Wilder organised a very good week-long demo and an excellent instruction session when it was delivered."

The course opted for three-wheel drive to cope with one or two slopes that can be testing in wet weather. From an operator view, the Baroness has proved to be quieter than the competition – and 6ft 3in Kevin soon found it comfortable after a quick adjustment.

The team's pride in the popular nine-hole course is very evident. Set amongst mature oaks and chestnuts in glorious countryside just north of Winchester and close to the source of the River Itchen, it lies in the grounds of the Georgian Avington Park mansion which now serves as a wedding and conference venue.

In days gone by the Georgian mansion is reputed to have been a favourite haunt of Charles II for romps with Nell Gwynne whose name is perpetuated on the golf course amongst the names given to each tee. It may only be nine holes but the course is tight and in places very challenging for both members and the legion of pay-and-play enthusiasts who use it and value its friendliness.

When you are a small greenkeeping team and have a full day's work ahead, you need to have confidence in the machinery you work with. It's important not just that it will do a good job but that adjustments and maintenance are quick and easy and that the potential for breakdown is minimal.

For Kevin Whatley, Head Greenkeeper at Hampshire's Avington Park Golf Course, a greens mower beauty contest involving all the industry's major manufacturers told a revealing story. "Without naming names, one was too complicated and computerised, another was awkward to work with and the third was too noisy," says Kevin. "Then we looked at the Baroness 315GC and it stood out not just on its clean cut but the fact that it was so much easier to work with and quieter to operate."

Two months on from taking delivery of their Baroness machine from Lister Wilder, Kevin and colleague Martyn Cooper are very happy that the decision they recommended to their boss, Robert Stent, was the right one.

"It's very easy to adjust and simple to use and maintain," says Kevin. "It comes naturally to start it up and run with it and we have only had to adjust it twice in six weeks. I took the units off today in order to check the groomers and you need no spanners — there are just a couple of quick release clips, which makes it so easy and quick. You lift the bonnet and all that you want is there and very obvious, which is great given that we do our own maintenance."

The power for the Baroness 315GC comes from a 21hp Kubota diesel engine. The cutting width is 152cm, with mowing heights from two to 29mm and a cutting speed of 6kph the LM315 has it all.

BARONESS SAILS THROUGH BEARSTED TEST

IN THE UNPREDICTABLE BRITISH CLIMATE, WORKING IN THE WET IS A FACT OF LIFE FOR GOLF COURSE GREEN KEEPERS. IT IS, HOWEVER, ALWAYS A FRUSTRATION WHEN DAMP GRASS MAKES A MESS OF THE FINAL PRESENTATION.

When Head Green Keeper Gary Williams decided the time had come to replace a fairway mower at Bearsted Golf Club in Kent, the facility to work in the wet or after a heavy dew was high on his checklist.

On a damp demo day, he sent one of his team off on the Baroness and told him to return if the weather worsened. But when it did rain, the operator didn't come back. He just carried on working - and was very happy with the outcome.

With Baroness scoring equally on Gary's other requirements, it was local agent Lister Wilder which subsequently collected the order for a Baroness LM2700 five-unit cylinder fairway mower.

Gary has worked at the 6,345-yard (par 71) parkland course near Maidstone for more than 30 years, joining as a trainee green keeper and quickly discovering he loved it. "I have friends who work indoors who tell me that it must be a

horrible job in winter but the reality is that you get only a few really cold days and mostly its fine to work," he says.

The course dates back to 1895 and has undergone many changes, growing from nine to 18 holes in 1923. Drainage has always been one of its challenges, a problem overcome in the mid 1990s when it was rebuilt to UGSA spec with a full drainage system. Since then, it has also benefitted from a more intensive management programme with greater resources available to Gary, who has a team of five.

The course hasn't looked back from that point and has attracted a number of major events – and a good few discerning golfers on their way to the Open at Sandwich. In June, it hosted the Kent amateur championships.

While not dedicating its grass cutting to any one brand, the fairways mowing has very largely been handled by one brand of machinery over recent years. "Baroness came onto the market and so we had a look at it," says Gary.

"We used it for first time a couple of years ago and were very impressed with the way it cut, especially in the wet. When the time came to change, we had another look at it alongside our existing brand's latest machine. We sat down as a team and discussed both machines and I asked the guys which they would prefer.

"We decided both were strong machines but the Baroness pipped its rival at the post. I like basic things and am not keen on computerised machinery that I can't fix myself - and that was the main difference. If you get a problem with a computer-controlled machine and it shuts down you don't know what on earth is wrong unless you attach a computer to it. If you have a problem with a Baroness, you can often fix it yourself. If you can't, you can still use it by taking one of the five units out of operation."

He adds: "There was a lot else we liked about the Baroness. The power output was far greater than the equivalent competitor machine, the units are bigger and it has tungsten bottom blades and cylinders, so there is less likelihood of bottom blades being replaced regularly. We are hopefully looking at three years before we have to change the bottom blade."

"The fact that Lister Wilder was the dealer was also a big plus. I use them for servicing on all my machines because it is a company that I trust and I know a number of the guys there really well. I knew that if we had a problem the back-up would be there."

The course has slightly smaller units on its other fairways mowers, which Gary has found leave a lot of wet grass lying around compared with the larger and more powerful Baroness.

"When we demoed it, I told one of the guys to take it out and if it starts raining heavily and leaves a mess to come back - but he didn't come back! When I did catch up with him he simply said: 'It's great. It isn't leaving any mess and cutting very well!'

"If I send two people out (to cut fairways), one on the Baroness and the other on our old mower, the one on the Baroness will always finish first and do a great cutting job."

And Gary's conclusion on the Baroness? "I would recommend it," he says without hesitation. "I am hoping for two in due course, and at the moment buying the second wouldn't be an issue."

Bryanston School invests in Baroness

High Marks for Baroness

Buried deep in Dorset countryside, Bryanston School has a reputation for innovation and for providing a platform for pupils who go on to make a mark on the world. Designer and Habitat founder Sir Terence Conran went there, as did adventurer and TV presenter Ben Fogle and actress Emilia Fox of Silent Witness.

Each of them and many more will doubtless testify to the fact that the 400 acres of spectacular grounds at this top notch public school had a big part in shaping their formative years. Keeping them looking good is not, therefore, something that the school takes for granted – and that includes the 60 acres devoted to sports pitches.

With seven rugby pitches, three cricket squares, athletics facilities and no fewer than 36 tennis courts (ten of them grass), it is not surprising that Bryanston also has a reputation for producing England under-18 rugby players and girls under-14s county hockey champions. It adds up to a lot of grass that needs cutting to a rigorous programme – a task that now relies on Baroness GM2800 and LM2400 mowers from Lister Wilder.

The switch to the Japanese brand that is making such a big impact on Britain’s golf course market was one that Head Groundsman Rob Froud had not anticipated. He and his team have had demons with two other manufacturers machines before responding to a recommendation to try a Baroness from Lister Wilder.

“I had done my research on the others but didn’t really even know the Baroness name,” says Rob. “I wasn’t here on the day it was demoed but then I got a call from the lads saying ‘this is incredible - you have to try it!’”

“It was a wet April day and we had just top dressed the rugby fields when I took it out. I cut an outfield and it did the job perfectly, left no mess and recycled the cuttings. I then checked the cut on the mower and that hadn’t changed. The decision (to buy the LM2400) was then an easy one.”

He adds: “I like the fact that the cutting cylinders run at high speed so it cuts well without tearing the grass whilst maintaining a quick forward speed. I also like that you can individually switch the cylinders to backlap, which makes maintenance very easy.”

Perhaps most significant for Rob was the sheer simplicity of a machine that

has little to go wrong because, unlike some others, it is not encumbered with a mass of computerised controls. “It has a reliable Kubota engine which our mechanic can look after,” says Rob. The same ease of use flows through to changing the height of cut which, at Bryanston, means switching regularly for different sports.

With the LM2400 lightweight fairway cylinder mower with its 2.8 metre cutting width having proved its capabilities for over a year, it was a natural follow-on to order the powerful and flexible GM2800 semi-rough mower rotary in the summer of 2016. Also cutting at 2.8 metres, the GM2800’s five units quickly cover large areas, with the free movement of the decks meaning that it easily follows contours and avoids scalping.

Rob comments: “Changing height on the other machines we looked at was a painful process that would need our mechanic whereas, once you know what you are doing, anyone can adjust the Baroness in a couple of minutes.”

And when the blades need changing our mechanic can do that in no time.”

A working Head Groundsman who likes to be hands-on amongst his small team, Rob has been at Bryanston for 15 years. He started as a trainee and was promoted from deputy to the lead role in 2009 when his predecessor, Ade Cross, sadly died after 21 years in the role. Rob is only the fourth Head Groundsman in some 88 years, which says much about the school’s approach to its staff.

The flexibility it offers also means that Rob makes light of long days that may start before 6am and in peak summer months involve middle of the night watering of tennis courts that are in constant use from 10am to 8pm. Achieving high quality surfaces for each sport is his mission and he enjoys good relationships with the individual members of the sports teaching

staff who appreciate his efforts. The first team cricket square is now rated as one of the best in Dorset.

The school’s summer holidays are the busiest time for the grounds team who have to keep the sports surfaces up to high standards for a succession of courses and set up equipment.

Lister Wilder has an increasingly important role to play in supporting Bryanston’s massive grass cutting programme and has recently also supplied two machines from its Kubota range – a F3890 out front mower and a G21 ride-on mower for use by the woods team in looking after banks and verges.

course and we are very happy with it,” he says. “It is well built and reliable and the blades are especially good. We have our own grinder but they are so good that you can go two or more seasons without needing to grind.”

“The fact that the new rough mower has rollers to produce summer striping makes a big difference to the appearance of the larger areas of the course. It all then looks more professional.”

He adds: “We demoed the new Baroness against rough mowers from all the other leading brands and it was the little things that made the difference.

“The size of the deck is very important given our undulations so the fact that it is heavier than others means that it follows the ground contours very well. We also like the fact that you can swivel the rear deck for easy maintenance and cleaning; and the height adjustment is very quick and easy for the operator.”

He adds: “The dealer factor is important to us – Lister Wilder works hard and Ian Davies (area sales manager) has been particularly good. We also like the fact that they have a depot close to us in Cirencester.”

The arrival of the GM2800 means that the hard working previous rough mower can now focus its attentions on the semi-rough. Working in tandem the pair will, Richard believes, further boost the standing of an impeccably maintained course.

Opened in 1910, the course was designed by James Braid who, seven weeks after its launch, won the

Open. The course lies two miles to the north of Cirencester at a point where the eastern slopes of the Cotswolds drop down to the surrounding plain.

Richard’s association with the course began as a junior member in the late 1980s and continued with a spell of work experience as he pursued his HND in golf course management. He worked at Minchinhampton Golf Course for three years before joining Cirencester as deputy in 2001 and then taking over as Course Manager six years later.

The fact that the course lies on free-draining limestone is a considerable bonus. “It means we are open right through the year,” says Richard. “We don’t close our greens during frosty weather and I have yet to see any damage from doing so. The club is a vibrant one and we have had a good year in terms of attracting new members. The new Baroness will help us to make it even more appealing.”

The five-deck mower has a powerful Kubota engine, achieving a maximum speed of 16kph with on-demand four-wheel drive making it both comfortable and safe to use on the most demanding Cotswold slopes and tight turns.

Simple refinements that add further to the Baroness LM2700 safety credentials include a protective net behind the driver’s head to deflect wayward golf balls. “It hasn’t happened to me,” says Richard. “But I have had near-misses and that little extra could make a big difference.”
